Application & Reporting Deadlines

1st Cycle:

Application Due:	Friday October 26th, 2018
Award Notification:	Week of December 3rd, 2018
Project Implementation:	January-May 2019 (Funds must be spent)
Final Report Due:	Friday June 14th, 2019

2nd Cycle:

Application Due:	Friday April 5th, 2019
Award Notification:	Week of May 6th, 2019
Project Implementation:	August-December 2019 (Funds must be spent)
Final Report Due:	Friday January 10th, 2020

Grant Amounts

Thanks to the generous support of our donors and community members, Greenwood Education Foundation is pleased to offer approximately \$15,000 in grants each awarded cycle year via two programs:

- 1) ***Education Innovation and Excellence***- GEF prefers to give these grants in the range of \$500-\$1500 however smaller or larger grant amounts may be considered based on demonstrated project impact and outcomes.
- 2) ***Professional Development***- Professional development grants support the growth, development, and leadership of our corporation staff. Applicants for this funding stream must work with the Building Principal and District PD Coordinator.

*The Professional Development Grants are a pilot for the Foundation for 2018-2019 and as such a very limited number are available.

Eligibility

All employed staff and administrators in the Greenwood Community School Corporation are encouraged to apply.

We will only accept one application per individual per cycle as a project lead

Collaborative grants across buildings and departments are strongly encouraged (please note- there is no limit to the amount of collaborative grants an applicant can be a member of)

How to Apply

NEW THIS YEAR! Applications and evaluations MUST be submitted via the online grant application and reporting form. We are no longer accepting paper applications via interoffice mail OR as email attachments.

Grant applications will be anonymously reviewed by members of the Greenwood community. Applications with the highest scores will be presented to the Greenwood Education Foundation Board of Directors for final approval.
