

### Supplies Needed for Kindergarten 2016-17

- 1. A book bag large enough to hold a folder without bending it NO wheels on it! This needs to come to school every day.
- A clean pillow case (this will be used to make a bag to hold coat & book bag during the day to help keep things together) Please put name on pillowcase with permanent marker.
- 3. a pair of shoestrings (36" or longer) (for strings for the bag) Put these inside the pillowcase)
- 4. At least one box of Kleenex
- 5. a pair of blunt Fisckars scissors (please, Fisckars only) Please put name on scissors.
- 6. Pink Pearl Eraser
- 7. Glue sticks (at least 4) (Large ones please!)
- 8. a plastic supply box (Please put name on box)
- 9. <u>3</u> packages of 8 count (<u>CRAYOLA</u> only please) regular size crayons <u>AND</u>
  - 2 package of 24 count (CRAYOLA only please) regular size crayons (some will be saved for later use in the year)
- 10. 2 Poly (plastic) 2 pocket folders with prongs (please put name on them)
- 11. 2- Composition Theme Notebooks (not spiral bound) (9  $\frac{3}{4}$  in. X  $7\frac{1}{2}$  in.)

\*Please donate the following items according to the first letter of your child's last name.


- A-F 1 container of baby wipes and 1 pkg. of 12 oz. Styrofoam bowls


