

To the Greenwood School Community:

I wanted to provide an update to you regarding the district's COVID-19 (coronavirus) planning. Before I do that, I want to first thank all of you for your support, patience, and understanding as we work through the dynamics of this ever evolving situation. As you are aware, three adult cases in Johnson County were confirmed on Wednesday of this week. We have continued to follow the lead of our county medical experts with regard to any recommendations for school closure.

I am sure I don't need to tell anyone that spring break begins in our district this Saturday. Out of good caution, at the close of school activities Friday night, we will not be hosting any school related activities open to the public through Sunday March 29th. We have also canceled use of our facilities to outside groups during this time period. At the secondary level, spring related sports practices or club related practices will be allowed to take place. Coaches and sponsors will communicate regarding their respective activity.

As spring break evolves, we will assess the current situation and communicate plans for how school and related activities will look beginning March 30th. I will reiterate that we are planning for the various possibilities that were outlined in my earlier communication last Sunday.

Again, thank you and please know that as events change, there may be a need to change our plans as well.
